



Key information for Host Organizations 2020 - Round I

The internship

- Duration: 2 to 6 months
- Period: May 2020 - May 2021 (round I); Feb 2021-Dec 2021 (round II)
- Focus: preferred on EU projects, might not be mandatory. Host Organizations, trainee and sending university will agree the tasks.

The costs

- Host Organizations participate free of charge
- Students receive an Erasmus+ scholarship and insurance

Requirements to participate

- Any organization can host interns: SME's, larger companies, municipalities, non-profit associations, universities, etc. The only organizations banned are bodies of the EU institutions.

Other requirements for Host Organizations

- core business must be coherent with the EU values
- must provide a tutor present at least 3 times per week
- must provide a workstation, desk, internet connection etc.
- must fill in EU4EU surveys

How many trainees per Host Organization?

- Maximum 10 trainees per round
- Ratio 3 staff for maximum 1 trainee

The Matching phase

- **The Matching phase round I starts on 20 March 2020**
- By that date you must apply as Host Organization on [EU4EU Portal](#).
- If your registration is approved you'll see and filter candidates profiles.
- Select the ones you prefer and schedule skype interviews.
- If the interview is successful you'll sign a Letter of Availability.
- You will be notified if the trainees you selected won the scholarship.
